This work will involve upgrades to sewer and water and related pavement restoration that will necessitate lane closures and a revised traffic plan in the vicinity of Exchange Street and Roosevelt Avenue. The traffic mitigation plan in this area is reflected on reverse side of this notice. Detours with lane closures will be marked with signage.
